

## Indoor Visitor Protocols

**The following core principles must be practiced to reduce the risk of COVID-19 transmission during visitation:**

- Residents are limited to two visitors at a time.
- Visitors must sign in and out using the Accushield kiosk with every visit to screen for signs and symptoms of COVID-19.
  - Entry will be denied for those with signs or symptoms, or those who have had close contact with COVID-19 infection in the prior 14 days (regardless of the visitor's vaccination status).
- Visitors should perform hand hygiene (use of alcohol-based hand rub is preferred).
- Visitors must wear a face covering or mask that covers the mouth and nose at all times when entering the facility.
  - Fully vaccinated visitors may remove their face covering or mask with fully vaccinated residents while in the resident room. Food and drink may be brought in for the resident to enjoy at the time of the visit.
  - Unvaccinated visitors must wear a face covering or mask at all times regardless of the resident's vaccination status. Food and drink may be brought in for the resident to enjoy after the visit, due to the required removal of the mask.
- Visitors should social distance with at least six feet between individuals in common areas.
- COVID testing is not required for visitation.

Indoor visitation will be prohibited if a resident or employee tests positive for COVID-19, or if the resident is on precautions related to exposure to COVID-19, and during outbreak testing. Compassionate care visits will be allowed at all times (ie. Hospice, end-of-life, acute critical/serious illness or condition).

The core principles must be maintained during indoor and outdoor visitation.
